Our Week at Glaisdale School

In Key stage 1 this week, the children enjoyed the first Forest schools session of the term. Mrs Webster's lessons have been focussing on the story of 'The secret garden' By Frances Hodgson Burnett – the children enjoyed the film adaptation and created their own story boards. In Mrs Scholey's lesson the children have used non-fiction books and the internet to research information for the new topic, India.

Year 3 enjoyed their forest schools session again this week. In Maths, the key stage 2 children have been working hard on understanding place value. Meanwhile in English, the children have been writing descriptions of a local legend, called the Barguest. As part of our Yorkshire topic we have been exploring Ordnance survey maps and getting to know our local area a little better.
