Our week at Glaisdale School

Class 1 This week in English, we have been looking at the structure of *The Secret Garden* and boxing it up into both 3 and 5 five parts in order to help us to learn the story better. We have also begun looking at our story map of the book and will be rehearsing this on a regular basis. Older children have this week been focusing on place value in maths, using a variety of methods and manipulatives, whilst younger children have worked on counting and number recognition. In addition, we have undertaken further work on measuring with standard and non standard units and number bonds. In other subject areas we have experimented with tone using black and white paints to add shade and tint to a base colour; continued our study of India and looked at God's creations and the nature around us. **Class 2** In KS2 this week we have continued to work on editing our descriptive writing of *The Bargest*, a mythical character based in Whitby. In maths, work remains centred around place value and is use different mathematical applications. We have used circle time to put forward any worries and as a class come up with possible solutions for these worries whilst taking the opportunity to thank anyone who has done a kind deed toward another. The year 6 children have worked hard with Mrs Hutt looking at a piece of descriptive writing and analysing it to understand the features used so that they will be able to apply this to create their own fabulous stories.
