#### **Teaching Assistant Support in Adventurers**

We are pleased to announce that all checks have been conducted on our new teaching assistant, Miss McCabe, and she will begin working with us from next week. Miss McCabe will predominantly support Mr Wood and Adventurers but will also work with other children, covering classes and leading Breakfast Club on Fridays (once she has settled!) I know you will all join us in making her feel welcomed to the Glaisdale family! Whilst Miss McCabe settles, we will still have the support of Mrs Laverick for some days up until the Easter break – this will help on days when Mr Wood is out of school too.

#### **Moors School**

# World Book Day - 7th March

As you may be aware, as a Poverty Proofing trust, our schools have not been holding non-uniform days this year, so that families, especially those struggling most in the cost-of-living crisis, do not feel excluded.

However, with World Book Day (7th March) coming up, other trust schools/PTFAs have devised a fairer system to allow for this (and, potentially, other non-uniform days) to go ahead with an option of dressing up. This involves a mass collection of pre-loved costumes to a bank or uniform store. These could be costumes that are no longer wanted or simply costumes which will not be worn on the day (and therefore can be returned to their owner). Costumes would then be made available to ALL children, so that it is not identifiable which children have donated costumes and which are wearing one from home. This is also more environmentally friendly and more in line with how sharing Glaisdale is as a school community.

Glaisdale PTFA will be in touch to gather some of these costumes, in the hope that we can offer a similar facility for all children. However, you can bring outfits to school at the start/end of the day. Alternatively, they can be brought to the PTFA meeting next Tuesday.









Of course, children can still choose to wear their own costumes from home and there is no obligation to wear a donated costume (or wear one at all).

We hope this is a fair way for all children/families to feel they can be involved with these days.

# Explorers Trip to York - Wednesday 28th February

As part of their history learning on the evolution of the railways, Explorers will be visiting York's National Railway Museum. Children should arrive **at Lealholm School** by no later than 8.25am, so that we can have a prompt departure.
