Sports Day – Rearrangement

New Administrator

Mrs Gray, our new school administrator, will be working with Mrs Hutchinson on Tuesday next week, to familiarise herself with her new role and our Glaisdale Family. I am sure you will all make her feel welcome.

Transition Week

Next week, our children will be taking part in some form of transition at points in the week. Our Year 6 children will be spending time in their new secondary school; Year 2 children will spend time in their new class and our new starters will join us for the morning and lunch on Tuesday and Wednesday. We understand how important effective transition is and we are looking forward to supporting all our children with these changes so they feel positive about these (and not daunted by them). Please feel free to contact your child's teacher (or new teacher) if you feel your child requires more support.

Year 2 – Free School Meals from September

As our current Year 2 children advance to Year 3 (and Key Stage 2) they will not be automatically eligible for universal infant free school meals, as they are now. Meals will, therefore, be charged at the new rate of £2.75 per meal (the new cost from September for all meals).

Year 6 SATs Results

The Year 6 SATs results are due to be released on Tuesday 11th July (a week later than originally planned). This falls during the Year 6 transition week, so we aim to supply these via e-mail to parents on the release day. All other year groups' assessments will be shared in end of year reports.

Non-Uniform Day – Wednesday 19th July – Bring a 'bottle'

We will be holding a non-uniform day on Wednesday 19th July (the same day as the summer fair). For this privilege, children should bring in a 'bottle' which can be used in the tombola later that day. This bottle may contain alcohol (but this must be brought to school by an adult and given to a member of staff directly). The bottle may be something non-alcoholic, such as a beauty product, bubble bath or soft drink – it is open to your interpretation!

Explorers Trip to Whitby
