Year 6 Crucial Crew Visit

Our Year 6 children will be visiting 'Crucial Crew' in Scarborough on Monday. They will need to bring their own packed lunch for this day. Children will return at the later time of 4pm.

Sports Day

Our rearranged Sports Day will take place on Tuesday 18th July (9.30-11.45am) – weather-permitting! This will take place at 'The Quarry' to the rear of the school along the grassy path. We hope to see you there!

Please ensure children come to school wearing PE kit with a drink. Children should also bring their bikes and helmets for cycling events.

Moors School

Our final Moors School session will be <u>Tuesday</u> 18th July. This is the same day as Sports Day but children will not require any additional kit – they will take part in activities which can be completed in their PE kit.

Summer Fair

Our Summer Fair will take place on Wednesday 19th July (1.30-3.30pm – although parents can take their child earlier that day, if they wish).

Children may wear non-uniform for this day. For this privilege, children should bring in a 'bottle' which can be used in the tombola later that day. This bottle may contain alcohol (but this must be brought to school by an adult and given to a member of staff directly). The bottle may be something non-alcoholic, such as a beauty product, bubble bath or soft drink — it is open to your interpretation!

Year 2 – Free School Meals from September

As our current Year 2 children advance to Year 3 (and Key Stage 2) they will not be automatically eligible for universal infant free school meals, as they are now. Meals will, therefore, be charged at the new rate of £2.75 per meal (the new cost from September for all meals).
