Athletics – Key Stage 2 – Monday 27th November

Children in Adventurers will be attending an athletics event in Whitby on Monday 27th November. Please ensure children come to school in appropriate PE clothing and footwear.

School Pantomime Visit – Tuesday 12th December

You will soon receive communication regarding the upcoming visit to Billingham Forum to watch the pantomime *Jack and the Beanstalk* which will take place on Tuesday 12th December. The children will be out of school for the majority of the day, meaning that a packed lunch will be provided from school (for those that regularly have school meals) unless you inform us otherwise on the consent form.
