Welcome Back!

Key Stage 2 Trip to Middlesbrough

On Thursday 25th April, our Key Stage 2 children will be visiting Middlesbrough, as part of their RE and Art learning. They will be visiting a Gurdwara, learning how Sikhs worship and live their lives according to their religion. The children will then visit Middlesbrough Institute of Modern Art (MIMA) to enhance the art knowledge they have acquired this year. A consent form has been sent out for this. There will be no cost to parents on this occasion.

Moors School

Swimming

The hope is that children can now wear these hoodies in their final term of Primary School before they leave. These may be worn in replacement of the school jumper/cardigan.
