Mr Cooper's Support of Goathland Primary School and Mr Wood (Acting Head of School)

Families should have received a letter through MCAS this week regarding Mr Cooper's interim leadership of Goathland Primary School who are currently without a headteacher. As a result of this, Mr Wood will become the Acting Head of School at Glaisdale and should be the first point of contact for any school-related queries. Mr Cooper will remain as the Executive Headteacher of Glaisdale School but his time in school will be reduced to a half a day per week which will be spent ensuring the school continues to flourish under Mr Wood's leadership.
