Year 6 Trip to Whitby Secondary School and Whitby Archives

On Tuesday, Year 6 will be taking the early train to Whitby to visit their new secondary school, as well as Whitby Archives. This will give them an opportunity to see their new school with a tour alongside children from Castleton. After this they will visit Whitby Archives where they will be able to learn more about Glaisdale's history.
