### **Year 6 Crucial Crew Visit**

Year 6 enjoyed their visit to Crucial Crew on Wednesday, where they got to experience a range of workshops and activities led by our emergency services. The children learnt how to keep themselves safe in a range of scenarios.

### **PE/Moors School/Swimming in Autumn**

I am delighted to confirm that Mr Bates has agreed to continue teaching PE next year. However, due to changes to our timetable, these sessions will now be on a Monday afternoon. Therefore, children should come to school in PE kit every Monday. Dates for Moors School are yet to be confirmed, however, these will continue fortnightly for all children. These dates will be released in the first week back. Swimming will also look different next year with children now receiving five sessions in Autumn Term and five sessions in Summer Term.
