#### **New Teacher-in-Charge**

I am pleased to announce that we have successfully appointed Mrs Laura Barber to the position of Teacher-in-Charge, following interviews on Wednesday which saw an exceptionally strong field. Mrs Barber will be replacing Mr Wood who will be leaving us after Easter. Mrs Barber joins us with a great deal of experience in her current, senior role at Lockwood Primary School, where she has led several school initiatives, as well as stepped in as the Teacher-in-Charge and deputy roles on various occasions.

Mrs Barber will be joining Mr Wood for some handover during the coming weeks, ahead of her official start after Easter. We are looking forward to welcoming her to the team.

As a reminder, after Easter, Mr Cooper will no longer be the interim headteacher of Lythe and Goathland Schools and will be returning to his substantive role as Executive Headteacher at Castleton and Glaisdale School. He will be at Glaisdale for 50% of the week and will be supporting Mrs Barber in her new role.

#### **New School Administrator (Glaisdale and Castleton Schools)**

I am also pleased to announce that we have appointed Mrs Jenifer Littlewood to the position of School Administrator, following a recruitment process which saw significant interest. Mrs Littlewood will be replacing Mrs Gray who will be leaving us at the end of this half-term. They have already started handing over, ahead of Mrs Littlewood's official start after half-term.
