

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# **Breakfast Club Reminder**

A reminder that Breakfast club starts at 8am when staff are in place, set up and ready to receive children. In exceptional circumstances, occasional early arrivals may be accommodated by special arrangement, but we are unable to take children prior to 8am on a regular basis. Thank you. Our breakfast club takes place every morning in term time from 8am, at a cost of £3 per child per day, or £2.50 each for siblings attending together.

## Illness

Our school follows a strict 48-hour policy for sickness and diarrhoea cases. If your child has been unwell, please do not send them into school until 48 hours since their last episode has passed – this applies even if they are feeling well again, as they may still be contagious for a 48 hour period. This is essential to keep all our children, and staff, safe and well.
