PTFA – New members required!

Peat Rigg Residential

Our Year 5 and 6 children will be heading off on an exciting adventure next week! On Wednesday, children will depart to Peat Rigg Outdoor Centre where they will take part in a range of outdoor adventurous activities, including abseiling, zipline, caving, archery, bushcraft and much more!
