Dear Families and Friends,

School Performance

I was filled with immense pride this week watching our children perform in their Christmas performance. Despite all the busyness of this term, alongside all the events and trips, our children performed magnificently! Thank you so much for all your support as audience members and your contributions to buying tickets and contributing prizes to our PTFA raffles. In total, we raised an amazing £155!

Scarlet Fever (group A streptococcus)

You will no doubt have heard, through the news, that there has been an increase in cases of Scarlet Fever (commonly being referred to as 'strep') amongst school age children. To ensure everyone's safety in school, we have sent out a guidance letter this week to outline the possible symptoms of this illness so that parents can remain vigilant. We would encourage any parent with a child displaying symptoms of Scarlet Fever (see below) to contact their GP. In the majority of cases, this illness is easily managed through antibiotics (although children should not attend school for 24-hours after receiving their first antibiotic dose.

If your child is diagnosed with Scarlet Fever, please inform school immediately, as we may need to inform our local Health Protection Team of any possible outbreak (where there are multiple cases occurring within 10 days of each other). Although we have had a number of seasonal illnesses and absences, the school is not experiencing an outbreak of Scarlet Fever or 'Strep' at this time.

Please be vigilant for the following symptoms:

- High fever
- Difficulty swallowing and/or tender enlarged lymph nodes
- A rash (usually develops on the first day of a fever and is red, generalised, pinhead in size, giving the skin a sandpaper-like texture
- The tongue has a strawberry-like appearance

In school, as usual, we are encouraging good hygiene behaviours and will remain vigilant for any of the above symptoms, informing parents immediately if these are displayed. We will also inform parents immediately if the school suffers an outbreak.

School Meals

We are currently receiving the help of cooks from East Barnby Outdoor Centre to provide hot meals. Wherever possible, we will try to inform you of any menu changes.

Please note: the school is now being charged extra per meal by NYCC County Caterers due to rising costs. This cost is not currently being passed on to parents and meal prices will, therefore, remain the same. This will be reviewed in February.

There will be no Moors School next week due to Adventurers being on their trip and Explorers completing their DT project.

Whole-school Pantomime Visit: Tuesday 13th December

The whole school will be visiting Billingham's Forum Theatre on Tuesday to watch the pantomime Beauty & the Beast!

Children should arrive at 9am outside The Robinson Institute wearing school uniform (with a coat). Children should bring their own packed lunch unless they have ordered one from school and a drink. Children who attend Breakfast Club will be walked down by staff at 8.30am (please do not arrive at school after this time).

We will return to school for a usual collection time.

KS2 York Trip: Thursday 15th December

Adventurers Class will be heading to York on Thursday to visit the Jorvik Centre, Jorvik Dig and Van Gogh Expo!

Children should arrive at 8am at <u>Lealholm School</u> where they will be taken by coach with Lealholm to York. They should wear uniform (with a coat), bringing their own packed lunch and drink (unless this has been ordered from school).

Children will return for a 4pm collection time from Lealholm School (although we will keep you posted if there are any delays).

Parent Governor Vacancy

With a changeable forecast next week, please check our Facebook page and your phone/e-mails for any updates on school closures caused by the snow/ice. The majority of our staff have to travel to/from Pickering/Whitby and, in the interest of their safety, we may sometimes have to close. Please always use your best judgement as to whether you think it safe to travel from home to school – we understand, given our rural locality, that we may experience more snow-enforced absences than other schools.
